INFORMATION ABOUT HOSTING ORGANISATION AND ACTIVITIES

Duration: 5 months, from the 1st of March to the 31st of July 2016.

General volunteers profile:

- 23-30 years old (it is possible also to be younger, if the person is quite mature)
- strong motivation to undertake an intercultural experience
- interest on agriculture/gardening
- interest on educational and social inclusion activities

General planned activities: EVS volunteer will work for 30/35 hours per week, supported by youth workers. Every week they will able to work at:

- a) office of the hosting organization,
- b) local partner organization (educational centre),
- c) urban garden.

During the 5 months they will plan and organize local public gardening activity/workshop (at least 5, 1/month) in local educational centres and urban garden. Moreover, they will take care of urban garden weekly. At least 100 youngsters/partner will be involved in these gardening activities. Since the project focuses on the inclusion of youth with fewer opportunities, the volunteers will work alongside disadvantaged or minority groups. From each weekly activity, EVS volunteers will collect content for the Open Educational Resource that CESIE will develop supported by the partner organisations.
