THE INTERNATIONAL TRAINING COURSE

that will take place in Beja, Portugal.

GREENTREPRENEURSHIP is a business activity that involves innovations, which reduces pollution, efficiently manages local resources and establishes conditions for a decent work while making production process or product more sustainable.

WHO WILL PARTICIPATE

Six partner organizations from Italy, Portugal, Slovenia, Nepal, Argentina and Tanzania. Each organization selects 4 youth leaders and 1 project leader.

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

Training is aimed for:

- Youth leaders aged between 18 and 35
- Youth leaders willing to be active in the field of green entrepreneurship and youth work
- Youth leaders willing to raise skills about green entrepreneurial skills for youth employment

THE CONTENT OF THE TRAINING

The training is aimed to raise the skills of youth leaders needed for promotion of green skills for youth employability and to train them in delivering a green entrepreneurship educational program for young people (unemployed, NEET).

Activities that will take place: Beja, Portugal

THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTICIPANTS



The participants are obligated:

1. during the training in Portugal
 - To actively participate in all the planned activities during their stay in Portugal
2. after returning home
 - to organize workshops to implement newly gained knowledge and skills
 - to become a member of local working group of the GREENTREPRENEURSHIP project and to contribute to the implementation of the local activities

The training will be held in English only, so all the participants are required to be able to communicate in English.

VENUE AND TIME OF THE TRAINING

The 7 days training will take place from 7th to 14th April 2016, in Beja, Portugal.

TRAINING COSTS

The project is co-funded by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union.

Training, boarding and lodging costs are covered by the organizer.

Travel costs will be covered to a maximum of:

Italy – 275 EUR/participant

Slovenia – 360 EUR/participant

Argentina – 1100 EUR/participant

Nepal – 1100 EUR/participant

Tanzaniya – 820 EUR/participant

Additionally participants from Nepal, Tanzania and Argentina can receive till 90 EUR/participant for visa and visa-related costs.
