

# The project « Burnt in memories » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

5 events have been carried out within this project:

#### Event 1: Seminar of Oral History

Participation: The event involved 30 citizens, including 28 participants from Slovenia and 2 from Italy. Location / Dates: The event took place in Koper (Slovenia), from 12/10/2015 to 16/10/2015. Short description: The aim of the event was to present the methods of Oral History to students of Humanities, emphasizing the role of memories in historical research in the case of the villages, burnt during World War II in the Operational Zone of Adriatic Littoral.

#### Event 2: Documentary project

Participation: The event involved 205 citizens, including 140 participants from Slovenia, 25 participants from Italy, 40 participants from Croatia.

Location / Dates: The event took place in Šmarje near Koper (Slovenia), Žejane (Croatia), Miren (Slovenia), Dolina (Italy) and Nova Gorica (Slovenia), from 18/02/2017 to 24/02/2017.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to present the documentary shot within the scope of the project. The documentary shows the memories of the arsons of the villages in the Borderland between Italy, Slovenia and Croatia during the German occupation in World War II.

## Event 3: Touring photo exhibition

Participation: The event involved 1800 citizens, including 300 participants from Slovenia, 200 participants from Italy, 1300 participants from Croatia.

Location / Dates: The event took place in Mačkolje (IT), Šmarje (SI), Lipa (CRO), Pazin (CRO), Žminj (CRO), Fažana (CRO), Medulin (CRO), Pula (CRO) and Nova Gorica (SI) from 01/06/2016 to 28/02/2017.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to exhibit the photos of the villages burnt during World War II and to raise awareness between people regarding the tragic events that experienced civilian population.

## Event 4: Round table

Participation: The event involved 80 citizens, including 55 participants from Slovenia and 25 participants from Croatia.

Location / Dates: The event took place in Koper (Slovenia) on 18/01/2017.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to discuss the politics of memory related to the violence during World War II; streaming live enabled people to follow the event via internet. At the round table participated students of University of Primorska, while students of University of Pula and University of Zagreb followed it on internet.

#### Event 5: Memorial cubes

Participation: The event involved 145 citizens, including 80 participants from Slovenia, 25 participants from Italy, 40 participants from Croatia.

Location / Dates: The event took place in Šmarje (SI), Žejane (CRO), Miren (SI) and Dolina (IT), from 18/02/2017 to 24/02/2017.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to present the memorial cubes, which were installed in collaboration with municipalities or local communities to commemorate the burnings of the villages. Memorial cubes are also information points with information about the war events in Šmarje, Žejane, Miren and Mačkolje.
