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## **SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT:**

### **Description of the TC:**

The Training Course KEY FOR FUTURE is an international training course focused on the development of the key competences within the concept of the non-formal education with the emphasis on the support of creativity, invention, entrepreneurship to achieve better state in the labour market through the application of the learning outcomes of the international youth project and base for further personal development.

### **Aim:**

The Training Course is aimed at the development of the quality educational activity offering the space to explore the creative approach and entrepreneurship as a part of the personal development which is an important part of the international youth projects and future success input for employability. The Training course is contributing to the development of the quality in the youth project's learning process and its elements.

### **Objectives**

1. Develop the competencies and capacity of the youth workers of the partner organizations, especially creativity, invention and entrepreneurial spirit.
2. Analyze the potential of Erasmus + projects towards the labor market and personal development.
3. Create non-formal quality methods / projects that address key competences and their implementation
4. Find common understanding and the link between creativity, inclusion and entrepreneurship to implement.
5. Share and exchange experiences with other participants.
6. Support the creation of contacts and creation of quality networks.

Hosting and sending people for youth in action projects and international activities. We have different groups inside of the organization, like sport c, dance, workshop , mountains, travel club.

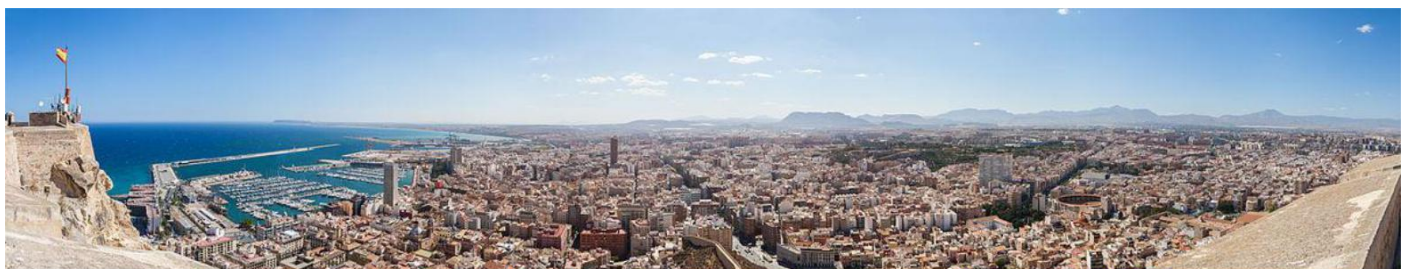
During the year we develop different training to give opportunity to improve their skills for unemployed and young people.

## **Place:**

Alicante both official names, is a city and port in Spain on the Costa Blanca, the capital of the province of Alicante and of the comarca of Alacantí, in the south of the Valencian Community. It is also a historic Mediterranean port. The population of the city of Alicante proper was 334,329, estimated as of 2011, ranking as the second-largest Valencian city. Including nearby municipalities, the Alicante conurbation had 462,281 residents. The population of the metropolitan area (including Elche and satellite towns) was 771,061 as of 2013 estimates, ranking as the eighth-largest metropolitan area of Spain.



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## **Financial aspects**

- Food, activities and accommodation is FREE.
- Participants will be reimbursed for the unit travel cost using the rules of the Erasmus +

## **Reimbursement conditions:**

The activity dates are 5<sup>th</sup> -11<sup>th</sup> November 2018. The travel dates are 5<sup>th</sup> November (arrival) and 11<sup>th</sup> of November(departure). Please keep in mind that we provide lodging only for the duration of the project and not more.

The organizers will reimburse for the unit travel cost using the rules of the Erasmus + from the home city to Alicante and from Alicante back home.

**(we will NOT cover insurance, taxi or car).**

Reimbursement of your travel costs can only be done upon submitting **ALL** the original tickets, invoices, boarding passes tags, etc. - or upon presenting the payment evidence along with the original ticket or e-ticket (with the boarding pass wherever applicable) and submitting us the respective copies + Mobility tool report and dissemination activities of the project.

**To be reimbursed, the participants need to take part in all the duration of the Training Course and all the activities.**

All the requested documents serve as supporting documentation for the Project Final Reporting (and reimbursement).

Reimbursement will be done in EURO, based on the exchange rates given by the Erasmus + Programme specifically the Spanish National Agency, and the rules for reimbursement and reporting.

The reimbursements will be done through **bank transfer** to one account number for each partner organization upon receiving all the original tickets, invoices and boarding tags **or in the training if you have all the documents + Mobility tool finish + Dissemination activities.**

! Four your reimbursement it is essential that you travel directly without any longer stop-over from your home town to Alicante in order to arrive and departure on the given project dates!

**! Note: The organisers will not provide any accommodation for an additional stay in SPAIN.**

The hosting organization is covering the accommodation ONLY fo the stay during the mobility. In case of earlier arrival or later departure, participants themselves must cover the accommodation. In addition, we can only cover tickets 1 days earlier or after the project date.

If you are planning to stay longer after the project or arrive earlier, please inform us before booking your ticket. Otherwise, we cannot guarantee your reimbursement. Please note any indirect routes taken for personal travel will not be reimbursed.



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## **Maximum amount Reimburse:**

Considering that participants are coming from different countries, please check the maximum amount of money that you have for the travel to Spain.

## **Safety & Insurance:**

Responsibility of the participants.

Health insurance will NOT be provided or reimbursed by the mobility organisers.

However, it is a mandatory requirement for all participants to provide your own health insurance. This should cover you for the full duration of your time in Spain.

If you are an EU resident, you can use the free European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) to allow you access to public hospital treatment. Having this card means you may be able to receive free medical treatment in the event of an emergency, but it is NOT guaranteed. Also please be aware that the EHIC is NOT a travel insurance policy, it will not cover private health care, non-emergency health costs, or being flown back to your home country. General travel insurance to cover the safety of your possessions, lost luggage, delays to flights, etc is NOT a mandatory requirement, but it is advisable.
