## The Idea

This project is created to bring together organisations which aim to increase their capacities regarding conflict management and inclusion of youth from vulnerable groups. With the help of non-formal educational methods this project is designed as a platform for exchanging realities, exploring the roots of conflict on an individual level, and to develop creative methods (including outdoor/digital activities).

The objectives of this project are the following:

- Exploring and clarifying the terms “conflict”, “conflict resolution”, “radicalization”, “inclusion”, “roots of conflicts” through international dimension of the youth work
- Development of competences, creative tools and methods for youth workers in their work towards reconciliation and inclusion of youth with fewer opportunities
- Development of new initiatives in the field of conflict management and active participation within the framework of the Erasmus+ program
- Promotion of EU democratic values and the importance of human rights education, tolerance and anti-discrimination

The participants should be able to communicate well in the working language - English.

Also, we require **active participation, punctuality and commitment** during the whole programme.



During this mobility, the participants will have different common tasks regarding the preparation of breakfast and keeping the dining room and kitchen clean after each meal.

The participants will receive the agenda including these tasks upon arrival. We expect responsible, flexible and engaged youth workers, who will foster team work by completing all tasks on time.

You are also invited to bring national food, drinks, music, so we can enjoy after the presentation of the tasks.
